CONCLUSION OF JUDGMENT

1. [REDACTED] shall live permanently with [REDACTED]
2. [REDACTED] born [REDACTED] shall have regular visitations with [REDACTED] from Mondays in even-numbered weeks until Mondays in uneven-numbered weeks. Mother picks up at and brings her back to the daycare centre/school.
3. Vacations and holidays are to be shared between the parents as follows:
 - The school's Christmas holiday is divided between the parents so that [REDACTED] spends the first part of the Christmas holiday with her father in 2022 and the second part of the Christmas holiday with her mother. In 2023 she shall spend the first part of the Christmas holiday with her mother and second part of it with her father etc. etc.
 - [REDACTED] shall be with her father during the school's winter holiday.
 - The school's Easter holiday shall be shared between the parents so that [REDACTED] spends the first half of the Easter holiday with father in 2023 and the second half of it with mother. In 2024 she shall spend the first half of the Easter holiday with mother and the second half of it with father etc. etc.
 - [REDACTED] shall be with father from 16th to 18th of May every year.
 - [REDACTED] shall be with mother on her birthday in 2023, with her father for her birthday in 2024, etc. etc.
 - Mother shall have visitations with [REDACTED] during weeks 1 and 2 and weeks 5 and 6 of the school's summer holiday every year. Father shall visitations with [REDACTED] during weeks 3 and 4 and weeks 7 and 8 of the school's summer holiday every year.
 - Mother shall have visitation with [REDACTED] during the school's autumn holiday and if they go to South Korea, she shall have an extra week of visitation in connection with the autumn holiday.

All visitations shall be carried out in accordance with the grounds of the judgment.

4. [REDACTED] shall pay court costs at the order of NOK 50 000 to [REDACTED] by 2 weeks from when the judgment is served upon her.

CONCLUSION OF THE COURT ORDER

1. The Conclusion of Judgment's items 1, 2 and 3 shall come into effect from when the judgment is passed and shall apply until the judgment is enforceable.

The court concludes its proceedings.
